### **GUIDELINES on ABSTRACT SUBMISSION**

1. Abstracts should highlight perspectives from relevant local, national, regional, international, or comparative research papers in the following **Theme and Sub-Themes of each parallel session**. The SEAMEO Congress' Technical Committee, who will be tasked to review the submitted abstracts, reserves the right to include a paper for consideration in a sub-theme other than the one you may identify if deemed appropriate.

#### **Theme and Sub-Themes**

##### **Parallel 1**

**Theme:** Transforming Education System and Learning Outcomes

**Sub-themes:**

- (1) Transforming Education for Quality and Excellence
- (2) Empowering Teachers and Learners to Address Learning Poverty
- (3) Health Literacy and School Nutrition

##### **Parallel 2**

**Theme:** Building a Future for the Alpha Generation

**Sub-themes:**

- (1) Eradicating Barriers to Learning
- (2) Resiliency: Mitigating Disasters and Pandemic-related Issues
- (3) Youth Skills ICT Opportunities in the Digital Age

##### **Parallel 3**

**Theme:** STEM Education Design for Improving the Quality of the Workforce

**Sub-themes:**

- (1) Policy Design for STEM Workforce
- (2) Interactive STEM Teaching Strategies
- (3) School Improvement to Strengthen STEM Education

##### **Parallel 4**

**Theme:** Sufficiency Economy Philosophy

**Sub-themes:**

- (1) Sustainable Community Learning and Climate Change
- (2) The Higher Education for the 21st Century
- (3) Human Capital Development in the Digital Society

2. It is recommended that abstracts follow the same format used at other international meetings and in journals. An acceptable structure for an abstract should include the background of the study, methods used in the study, results, and conclusion. Details of each component are as follows.
  - **Background:** A statement of the hypothesis or research question.
  - **Methods:** An explanation of the study design and experimental methods used in the study.
  - **Results:** A concise summary of the major findings of the experiment or study. The authors should provide sufficient data to permit evaluation by the Technical Committee.
  - **Conclusion:** Summary of the overall findings, the importance of the study, and perhaps recommendations for further study.
3. Abstracts are accepted into one of the following two categories:

- **Oral Presentation:** The presenting author will be required to make a 15-minute PowerPoint presentation.
- **Poster Presentation:** The author will present the poster during the poster session to which it has been assigned either on-site or/and through the e-poster platform.

Abstract accepted for oral and poster presentation will be published as part of the SEAMEO Congress Book/Kit to be distributed to Congress participants.

4. The first page of the submission should only contain the abstract (Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusion) and should identify a preferred sub-theme, track, and abstract category. It should not bear any marks identifiable to the author or authors. The abstract must be no longer than **300 words** in English. The second page should contain the author's name, title, affiliations, and location (city, state, and country) of each author; indicate the corresponding author using the email address of the corresponding author. In formatting, the text of the Abstract, a standard font, such as 12pt, Arial should be used. Abstract Template can be downloaded from <https://congress2021.seameo.org>.
5. Abstract submissions will be opened from **15 September – 31 December 2020**. Authors are advised to ensure that their abstracts meet the criteria and guidelines as indicated above. All abstracts should be submitted via the website <https://congress2021.seameo.org>. Notice of acceptance or rejection will be sent to the submitting authors by **15 January 2021**.
6. Authors whose abstracts are accepted for **Oral Presentation** shall submit the **full paper** by **15 February 2021**. Notice of acceptance or rejection will be sent to the submitting authors by **15 February 2021**. **A template of the full paper can be downloaded [here](#).**
7. Authors whose abstracts are accepted for **Poster Presentation** shall submit the digital poster (e-poster) by **15 February 2021**. The templates of the E-Poster can be downloaded [here](#).
8. By submitting an abstract the author/s retain the copyright of the paper but agree to allow publication of the submitted abstract and related information on the author in the SEAMEO Congress website, SEAMEO Congress Book, and other related SEAMEO Congress publications. Likewise, authors of accepted oral abstracts agree for SEAMEO to audio/video record all the presentations for future distribution.
9. Further information will be provided to the authors whose abstracts are accepted for oral or poster presentation. For abstracts with multiple authors, at least one author must attend the Congress to present the abstract. Oral or poster presenters will be required to pay the Congress registration fee.
